1. Required OS Environment

Windows(R) 7 (32bit / 64bit)

Windows Vista(R) (32bit / 64bit)

Windows(R) XP Professional

One of the above OS's should be worked normally.

#### 2. Required Hardware Function

Your computer should support USB 1.1 or later function, and should be installed one of above required OS. There is a case that you can not use it depending on your environment.

#### 3. Install Procedures

[Common Procedures]


1. Unpack the ADB USB driver file in your computer.

(File name of ADB USB driver is "FZ-A1B\_adb\_usb\_driver.zip".)


- 2. Turn on FZ-A1 and launch Settings application. Enable the USB debugging to put the checkmark on [Developer options] [USB debugging].
- 3. Connect FZ-A1 and your computer with USB cable.

## [Windows 7]


 Click Start button and select Control Panel. Select Hardware and Sound and open Device Manager. The FZ-A1B device appears at Other devices on Device Manager.




2. Right-click the FZ-A1B and select **Update Driver Software**. This will launch the Hardware Update Wizard. Select **Browse my computer for driver software**.



- 3. Click Browse and locate the unpacked ADB USB driver folder. Click Next to install the driver.
- 4. ADB USB driver is installed automatically and the following window appears after install process has been completed.



5. The Android Composite ADB Interface device appears on Device Manager.




### [Windows Vista]

1. OS will detect new hardware and launch the Found New Hardware Wizard. Select **Locate and install driver software (recommended)**.



- 2. Select Don't search online.
- 3. Select I don't have the disc. Show me other options..
- 4. Select Browse my computer for driver software (advanced).
- 5. Click Browse and locate the unpacked ADB USB driver folder. Click Next to install the driver.
- 6. ADB USB driver is installed automatically and the following window appears after install process has been completed.



7. Restart your computer to be available the driver.

## [Windows XP]

1. OS will detect new hardware and launch the Hardware Wizard. Select **No, not this time** and click **Next**.



- 2. Select Install from a list or specific location (Advanced) and click Next..
- 3. Select **Search for the best driver in these locations:** and put the checkmark at **include this** location in the search.

Locate the unpacked ADB USB driver folder and click Next to install the driver.

4. ADB USB driver is installed automatically and the following window appears after install process has been completed.



5. Restart your computer to be available the driver.
